

Stone Lake Elementary PTO General Meeting - March 13, 2018

The March meeting of the Stone Lake PTO was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Jessica Trudell.

Approval of January Board Meeting minutes: A motion was made by Patrina Baggett and seconded by Colleen Childers to approve the minutes from the January meeting. Jessica Trudell called for a vote to approve the motion. All present members were in favor; no objections or abstentions.

Approval of January Treasurer's Report: Kelly Manning reported on the January Treasurer's Report. Items mentioned: Box Tops and January Spirit Wear. A motion was made by Jacqueline Smith and seconded by Cher Pizante to approve the Treasurer's report from the January meeting. Jessica Trudell called for a vote to approve the motion. All present members were in favor; no objections or abstentions.

Teacher Appreciation Week May 7th-11th: Jessica Trudell reported that theme was unknown and requested ideas to be emailed to her.

Math Night 3-14-18: Heather Larrabee reported that high school volunteers are excited. There will approximately 10 stations for K-2 grade and 10 stations for 3rd grade and up. Principal's Report:

Mr. Beard reported on the following:

- Student Walk-Out 3/14/18: Students not allowed to leave campus due to safety issue. Have plan with teachers if occurs and will deal on a case by case basis.
- Staffing for next year: One new teacher hired for 3rd grade and 1 teacher retirement. Continued downsizing school due to enrollment decline.
- Survey time. Participation is greatly appreciated. Next Coffee Klatch important to get feedback for direction for next year.

Mrs. Baggett reported on mini grant (\$2,500) from Edmo to help with GATE program (10wk after-school program). Discussed likely day will be Wednesday's from 2pm-3:30pm. Open for 15 GATE identified students from 3rd to 6th Grade.

Open Forum: Jessica Trudell shared the PTO shed has been delivered. Jessica Trudell also shared opportunity for school to earn additional funding by Scholar Share Program. Online voting, vote 1 time a day until March 23rd. Funding of \$20,000 would go to PE equipment/grade level equipment.
