

Stone Lake Elementary School PTO General Meeting—October 9, 2018

The October meeting of the Stone Lake PTO was called to order at 6:33pm by Sabrina Raasch

Approval of the September General Meeting minutes: A motion was made by Amy Sazama and seconded by Patrina Baggett to approve the minutes from the September meeting. Sabrina Raasch called for a vote to approve the motion. All present members were in favor; no objections or abstentions.

Approval of September Treasury Report: Amy Sazama reported on the September Treasurer's Report. She reported income of \$961 from Jamba Juice cards and approximately \$17,000 from Boosterthon. Approximately \$1,579 was spent on 4-6 grade planners. Amy reported the Book Fair has been doing well and the Dudes and Donuts event was a huge success. A motion was made by Sarah Castro and seconded by Christine Goodwin to approve the September Treasurer's Report. Sabrina Raasch called for a vote to approve the motion. All present members were in favor; no objections or abstentions.

Boosterthon Update: The dates for the 2019-20 school year Boosterthon have been selected. The program will run January 21-February 13, 2020. The PTO has already paid Boosterthon's \$2,000 program fee to lock in the dates. We will again seek sponsors to provide the kids customized t-shirts. Sarah provided Heather with Mathnasium a thank-you gift for their continued support.

Fall Festival Update: Sarah passed around the Fall Festival program with the various silent auction items listed. The carnival will be staffed by 20+ volunteers from Cosumnes Oaks High School. Kid Central will help at the Trunk or Treat by providing a car and stamping hands to mark those who have been through the line already. A 7th grade Girl Scout troop will be providing two Trunk or Treat cars and volunteers. In the MP room will be the Book Fair, and for sale: cupcakes, popcorn, water and pizza (donated by Mathnasium). There will be a costume parade MC'ed by the DJ. Mrs. Shaw will be in charge of the silent auction.

Restaurant Night: Chik-fil-A will sponsor our next restaurant night on October 16 5pm-8pm. No flyer required as we get a portion of all sales during that time.

Drive Thru Dinner: On November 6 we will be providing a drive-thru dinner. More details to come at the next PTO meeting.

Principal's Report: Mr. Beard reported that on October 18, there will be an assembly for 3-6 graders featuring Joe Cepeda. Mr. Cepeda is a famous illustrator of books such as Esperanza Rising.

Mrs. Baggett's updates: Mrs. Baggett reported that October 10 is National Walk to School Day. She asked for parent volunteers to hand out stickers starting around 7:35am. There will be a Jamba Juice gift card drawing. Mrs. Baggett also reported that 3rd graders will have GATE testing on October 24. D Track 3rd graders will be tested on November 7. There will be a meeting next week to explain the GATE program to any parent who's interested (regardless of grade).

Open Forum: Sabrina reported that the person in charge of the cones for the school's back gate has requested new orange cones. Sabrina had looked into replacements but they are quite expensive (approximately \$350). Colleen will check with one or two construction contacts to see if we can get them donated or at a discount.
