

Stone Lake Elementary PTO General Meeting – February 12, 2019

The February meeting of the Stone Lake PTO was called to order at 6:32 p.m. by Sarah Castro.

Approval of January General Meeting minutes: A motion was made by Amy Sazama and seconded by Jessica Trudell to approve the minutes from the January 8 meeting.

Approval of January Treasurer's Report: Amy Sazama reported on the January Treasurer's Report. Items mentioned: \$33,600 has been raised for the year and \$37,000 was budgeted. Teacher reimbursements were made; \$3500 was paid for the Alliance Redwoods buses; \$500 donation was given by the Leu Family and Kaiser for the National Day of Giving. Patti McDougall asked about the grade level money they usually receive from the Fun Run. A motion was made by Jessica Trudell and seconded by Patti McDougall to approve the January Treasurer's report.

Yearbook update: Jessica Trudell reported that the yearbooks were on sale and the sale price was good until February 28th and would then increase starting March 1st through April 12th. We are still accepting 6th grade dedications and photos for the yearbook. We would prefer online sales, but will make exceptions if needed.

Art Ark Night: The Art Ark night will be on March 6th. PTO and Mr. Beard are working on a fundraiser for a rock garden. Details were discussed and more will be announced soon.

Math Night: The Mathnasium math night will be held on March 21st. The event will be from 6-8PM with PTO hosting a hot dog dinner on the stage kicking off the event at 5:30-7PM. PTO is looking for a few volunteers and asked teachers to recruit volunteers as well.

Penny Wars: The Penny wars will be from April 1st-12th. There will be a sign-up genius for volunteers and PTO is looking to only count money 3 times in the week, not daily. B track will be able to participate before tracking off. Flyers will be going out soon. This will be a grade level competition.

Ice Cream Social: The date is set for June 7th. It will be similar to last year, but PTO is requesting more baskets from classes rather than grade levels. Patti McDougall didn't think this would be fair due to some class sizes and tracks. PTO offered that classes team up. It was suggested that PTO give teachers a list of the top raffle baskets from last year. There will be the soft serve ice cream in vanilla and chocolate this year. Volunteer and chairperson information will be going out soon.

Principal's Report:

Mr. Beard had nothing to report on other than fingerprinting results are averaging 4-6 weeks out. Continue checking in with the office staff.

Open Forum:

- Sarah Castro reported on box tops. She thanked Chelsea Grow for her hard work for the box tops contest. The winning class was Ms. Tuckers first grade A track.
- Sarah Castro reported that PTO will be working on getting a newsletter out with all the important upcoming dates early next week.
- Discussion regarding the Raley's grant for the garden took place. The current hold-up is getting water to the area chosen for the garden – outside the computer room on the east side. The districts proposal was for \$2500 to get water to the area. 2nd grade is currently working to secure a field trip date.

- The upcoming restaurant night is February 21st at Mountain Mikes Pizza in the Raley's shopping center. They will not apply beer or wings towards the total donated back and no coupons will be accepted. Flyers coming home soon.
